

MOTION
NO. 526

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A MOTION providing authorization for King County to apply for funding assistance for open-space land acquisition for Highline Neighborhood Park No. 21 with the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development as provided in Title VII of the Housing Act of 1961, as amended; and amending Motion No. 131.

WHEREAS, by Motion No. 131, dated February 2, 1970, the County Council approved thirty-nine (39) park projects and authorized the submission of applications to the Department of Housing and Urban Development for grant assistance to acquire and develop permanent interest in land for open-space uses as provided for by Title VII of the Housing Act of 1961, as amended, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best public interest to increase the acreage of certain park projects thereby enhancing the usefulness of these projects, and

WHEREAS, the purchase cost to increase the acreage is within the funds authorized by County Resolution No. 34571;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

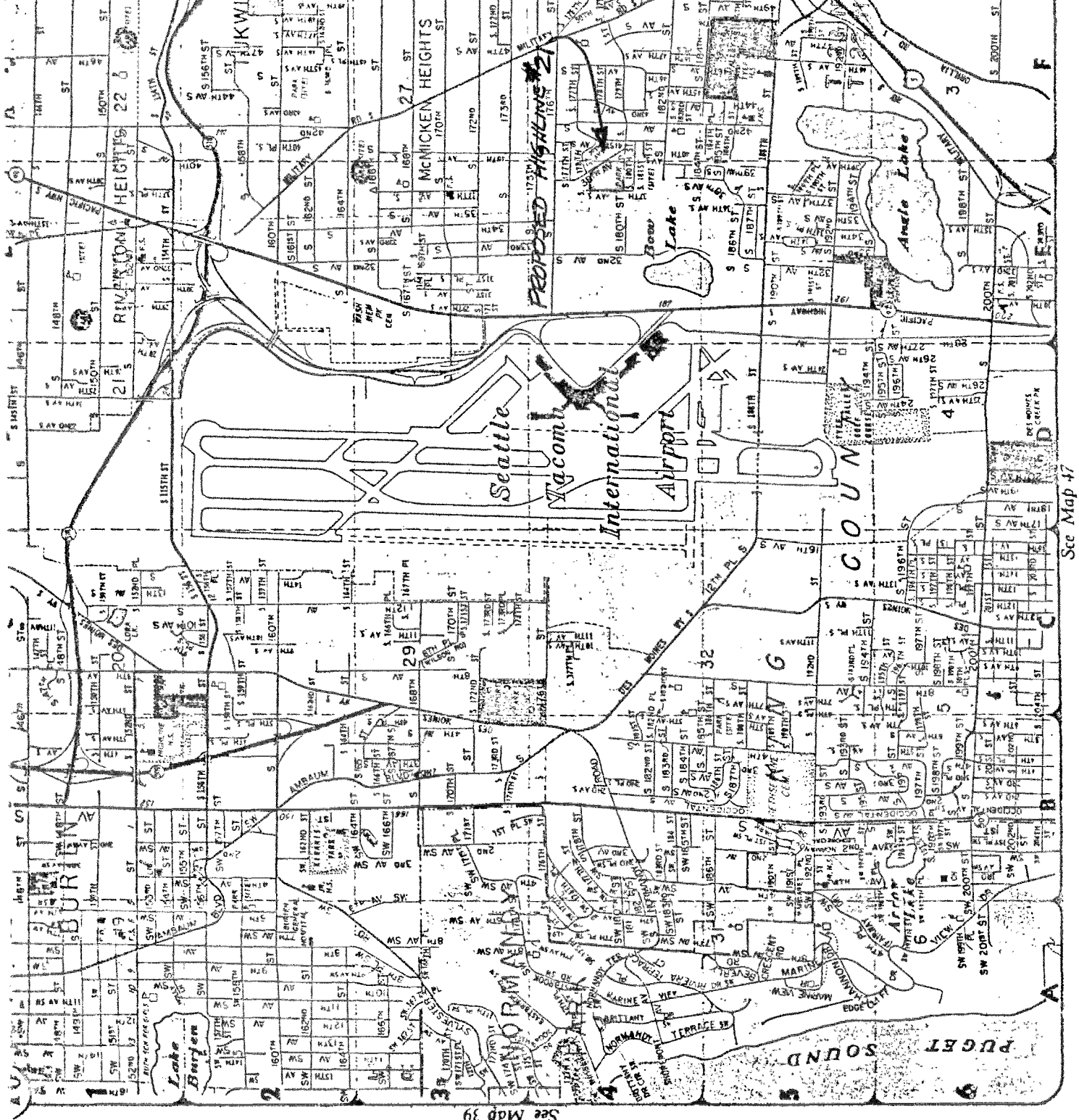
Authorization is given to submit an application to the Department of Housing and Urban Development for grant assistance and Motion No. 131 is amended to read: Highline Neighborhood Park No. 21, from 4.75 acres to approximately 7.37 acres and from \$70,000.00 to approximately \$221,010.00.
