

1 A MOTION supporting the passage of
2 State Referendum 26

3 WHEREAS, State Referendum 26 authorizes the issuance and
4 sale of a \$225 million bond issue for the construction of water
5 pollution control and solid waste management facilities, and

6 WHEREAS, these general obligation bonds will be repaid from
7 the State General Fund and not by local property taxes, and

8 WHEREAS, the proceeds of the bond issue will generate
9 State funds to attract additional matching federal funds for the
10 upgrading of present sewage treatment and solid waste facilities,
11 and

12 WHEREAS, King County will benefit not only from new facilities
13 but will receive many indirect benefits through new jobs and
14 improved facilities within the County.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

16 The King County Council hereby supports the passage of
17 State Referendum 26 and encourages the voters of King County
18 to vote in favor of State Referendum 26 in the November 1972
19 General Election.
