WHEREAS, State Referendum 26 authorizes the issuance and

sale of a \$225 million bond issue for the construction of water pollution control and solid waste management facilities, and

MOTION NO.

WHEREAS, these general obligation bonds will be repaid from the State General Fund and not by local property taxes, and

WHEREAS, the proceeds of the bond issue will generate State funds to attract additional matching federal funds for the upgrading of present sewage treatment and solid waste facilities,

WHEREAS, King County will benefit not only from new facilitie but will receive many indirect benefits through new jobs and improved facilities within the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: The King County Council hereby supports the passage of State Referendum 26 and encourages the voters of King County to vote in favor of State Referendum 26 in the November 1972
