A MOTION supporting the passage of State Referendum 27.

whereas, State Referendum 27 authorizes the issuance and sale of state general obligation bonds in the sum of \$75 million to provide funds for the planning, acquisition, construction, and improvement of water supply facilities, and

WHEREAS, the referendum provides for payment of the bonds from unpledged state retail sales tax revenues or other means authorized by the legislature, and

WHEREAS, passage of referendum 27 would result in (1) improvement of drinking water quality, (2) increase in water supply for homes and industries, and (3) development of irrigation lands for food and fiber production, and

WHEREAS, King County would benefit from a sufficient and safe water supply

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County Council hereby supports the passage of

State Referendum 27 and encourages the voters of King County

to vote in favor of State Referendum 27 in the November 1972

General Election.
