

1 A MOTION supporting the passage of  
2 State Referendum 28.

3 WHEREAS, State Referendum 28, authorizes the issuance and  
4 sale of state general obligation bonds in the sum of \$40 million  
5 to provide funds for the planning, acquisition, preservation,  
6 development and improvement of recreation areas and facilities,  
7 and

8 WHEREAS, the referendum provides for payment of the bonds  
9 from unpledged state retail sales tax revenues or other means  
10 authorized by the legislature, and

11 WHEREAS, passage of Referendum 28 would result in enlarged  
12 campgrounds, rest rooms, sewage and water facilities, fire  
13 protection equipment, boat launching ramps, dump stations for  
14 campers and trailers, trails to fishing and hunting areas,  
15 renovation of group camp buildings and points of historical  
16 significance, and

17 WHEREAS, King County will benefit not only from the new  
18 facilities but through new jobs and the opening of new recrea-  
19 tion areas within the County,

20 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

21 The King County Council hereby supports the passage of  
22 State Referendum 28 and encourages the voters of King County to  
23 vote in favor of State Referendum 28 in the November, 1972  
24 General Election.
