A MOTION supporting the passage of State Referendum 28.

WHEREAS, State Referendum 28, authorizes the issuance and sale of state general obligation bonds in the sum of \$40 million to provide funds for the planning, acquisition, preservation, development and improvement of recreation areas and facilities. and

WHEREAS, the referendum provides for payment of the bonds from unpledged state retail sales tax revenues or other means authorized by the legislature, and
