

1 A MOTION supporting the passage of  
2 State Referendum 29.

3 WHEREAS, State Referendum 29, authorizes the issuance and  
4 sale of state general obligation bonds in the sum of \$25 million  
5 to provide funds for planning, acquisition, construction and  
6 improvement of Health and Social Services facilities, and

7 WHEREAS, the bonds will be retired from unpledged state  
8 retail sales tax revenues or other means authorized by the  
9 legislature, and,

10 WHEREAS, the passage of State Referendum 29 will result in  
11 (1) additional residential facilities for the mentally retarded,  
12 (2) regional vocational rehabilitation facilities and sheltered  
13 workshops for disabled persons, (3) community-based correction  
14 facilities for both juveniles and adults, (4) facilities for  
15 drug users and alcoholics and (5) multi-service centers for the  
16 elderly, youth, those eligible for public assistance and others,  
17 and

18 WHEREAS, King County will benefit from these new facilities  
19 and from the creation of the new jobs generated by this con-  
20 struction,

21 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

22 The King County Council hereby supports the passage of  
23 State Referendum 29 and encourages the voters of King County to  
24 vote in favor of State Referendum in the November 1972 General  
25 Election.
