A MOTION supporting the passage of State Referendum 30.

WHEREAS, State Referendum 30, authorizes the issuance and sale of state general obligation bonds in the sum of \$50 million to provide funds for the planning, acquisition, construction, and improvement of public transportation systems, and

WHEREAS, State Referendum 30 provides for payment of the bonds from unpledged state retail sales tax revenues or other means authorized by the legislature, and

WHEREAS, passage of State Referendum 30 will provide for public transportation vehicles and equipment, bus stops, off-street parking areas and other public transportation improvements, and

WHEREAS, King County will benefit from this source of financeing within the State for public transportation equipment and
facilities.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County Council hereby supports the passage of State Referendum 30 and encourages the voters of King County to vote in favor of State Referendum 30 in the November 1972 General Election.
