SUBSTITUTE MOTION NO. 1002

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A MOTION concurring with the recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner on the Current Use Classification for open space petitioned by Vasa Home Association of State of Washington and designated File No. 210-72-S; modifying the conditions thereto.

THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL, by this Motion, does accept the report of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner attached hereto which was filed with the Administrator-Clerk of the Council on September 8, 1972, regarding the current use classification for open space petitioned by Vasa Home Association of State of Washington, designated by the Department of Planning File No. 210-72-S, and the Council does concur with the recommendations contained therein, subject to the following modifications to the conditions of approval:

- 1. Condition No. 1 of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner's report is modified to read:
 The rental of overnight camping and trailer space shall be limited to not more than thirty spaces of which not more than ten spaces shall be occupied by travel trailers, truck campers or motor homes at any one period of time.
- 2. Within sixty (60) days from the date of this motion, the applicant shall file with the King County Department of Planning a limited liability title insurance policy which shall show the names of all parties having a fee interest in the subject property. The names of all such owners, vendors and vendees shall be added to the Open Space Taxation Agreement before said agreement is signed by the Chairman of the King County Council.
- 3. Classification of the subject property shall be subject to the mutual covenants and conditions contained in Washington State Department of Revenue Form PTF 81, "Open Space Taxation Agreement", and subject to the

following conditions which shall be added to said Open Space Taxation Agreement form: a. Within one year from the effective date of the Open Space Taxation Agreement, the applicant shall obtain a Soil and Water Conservation Plan for the subject property from the King County Soil and Water Conservation District. b. Subject property shall be managed in accordance with said Soil and Water Conservation Plan during the term of the Open Space Taxation Agreement.
