

1 A MOTION requesting the King County Executive
2 and Property Management for property for use
3 by the Fire Chiefs' Association.

4 WHEREAS, the King County Fire Chiefs' Association has
5 established a committee to standardize and upgrade training for
6 the volunteer and paid fire fighters of King County; and

7 WHEREAS, this committee has been looking for some time
8 for property to establish a training academy in the King County
9 and Puget Sound area; and

10 WHEREAS, a training facility is very important to all
11 fire districts and cities and towns, including the City of
12 Seattle; and

13 WHEREAS, it is impossible for all districts and towns and
14 cities to finance their own individual training sites to the
15 best advantage; and

16 WHEREAS, the King County Fire Chiefs' Association with the
17 help of the Washington State Fire Service Training Program,
18 would establish a training facility, if property were available;

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

20 The King County Council requests the King County Executive
21 and the Director of Property Management to find a suitable piece
22 of property not being used by King County at the present time,
23 for the purpose of construction of a Training Academy by the
24 King County Fire Chiefs' Association, to include classrooms,
25 drill tower, and all necessary facilities for fire training
26 purposes.
