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2 A MOTION concurring with the recommendations
3 of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner on the
4 application for a Special Permit petitioned
5 by Soos Covington Property, designated File
6 No. 302-72-ZA, denying the Appeal and adding
7 conditions.

8 THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL, by this Motion, does accept the
9 report of the Zoning and Subdivision attached hereto which was
10 filed with the Administrator-Clerk of the Council on November
11 29, 1972, regarding the application for a Special Permit pe-
12 titioned by Soos Covington Property, designated by the Land Use
13 Management Division No. 302-72-ZA and the Council does concur
14 with the recommendations contained therein, denies the appeal
15 filed by Community Objectors and adds the following conditions
16 thereto:



- 18 1. The number of truck trips to and from the site shall
19 be limited to 75 round trips per day during the months
20 of October through May and to 100 round trips per day
21 during the months of June through September.
 - 22 2. Truck traffic travelling to and from the site shall
23 yield the right-of-way to school bus traffic when
24 crossing the bridge across Jenkins Creek on Covington
25 Way S.E., Bridge No. 3085.
 - 26 3. The Department of Public Works and Transportation is
27 requested to determine the traffic speed limits on
28 Covington Way S.E. which will assure the public safety
29 when the truck traffic generated by the site is added
30 to the existing traffic on that roadway, and to install
31 such traffic signs and devices as the Department de-
32 termines to be necessary to control traffic in the
33 vicinity of the intersection of the proposed access
road with Covington Way S.E.
