2 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to  
3 execute and submit a grant application to the  
4 State Law & Justice Planning Office for funds  
5 in the amount of \$299,849 to enable the King  
6 County Department of Public Safety to implement  
7 Phase III of the Law Enforcement Radio Communi-  
8 cations System.

9 WHEREAS, the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of  
10 1968, as amended, provides for the award of grants by the Law  
11 Enforcement Assistance Administration, U. S. Department of Justice,  
12 through the Washington State Law & Justice Planning Office, and

13 WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes the need to improve  
14 the communications system of the Department of Public Safety, and

15 WHEREAS, the County Council finds that an improved communi-  
16 cations system is in the best interest of the general public and  
17 will provide greater protection and safety to the general public,  
18 and

19 WHEREAS, King County recognizes its obligation to provide  
20 \$23,900 in-kind contribution and to provide \$87,000 in a cash  
21 match for support of this project,

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

23 1. That the King County Executive is hereby authorized to  
24 make application for funds in the amount of \$299,849 to the State  
25 Law & Justice Planning Office on behalf of King County;

26 2. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and  
27 directed to file and execute such application and contracts as  
28 are required by the State;

29 3. That the King County Law & Justice Planning Office is  
30 named the authorized correspondent for King County and is further  
31 authorized to furnish such additional information and documents  
32 as may be required by the State;

33 4. That the County Executive is also authorized to enter  
into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the  
implementation of the project.
