A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to execute and submit a grant application to the U.S. Department of Health, Education and Welfare for funds in the amount of \$50,000 for the development of a Comprehensive Youth Service System within the Department of Community Development/Division of Youth Affairs.

WHEREAS, the Juvenile Delinquency Prevention and Control
Act of 1968, as amended, provides for grant awards under the
program "Comprehensive Youth Service System for Prevention," and

WHEREAS, youth comprise a significant part of the population of King County outside the City of Seattle, and

"WHEREAS, there is a lack of social services available to potential juvenile delinquents to assist them and their parents in solving behavioral problems, and

WHEREAS, the establishment of a Comprehensive Youth Service System within King County would help to reduce recidivism and prevent juvenile delinquency,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- 1. That the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute and file an application with the U.S. Department of Health, Education and Welfare for a grant in the amount of \$50,000 for a Comprehensive Youth Service System.
- 2. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to execute such contracts as required by the U.S. Department of Health, Education and Welfare.
- 3. That the Federal/State Relations Division is hereby authorized to provide additional information and act as authorized correspondent.
