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MOTION NO. 1111

A MOTION authorizing the deletion of certain property from the application for current use classification of Twin Lakes Golf and Country Club designated as Land Use Management File No. 407-72-S.

WHEREAS the King County Council by Motion No. 1006 approved the current use classification petitioned by Twin Lakes Golf and Country Club, Land Use Management File No. 407-72-S, for approximately one hundred and eight acres of property commonly known as the Twin Lakes Golf Course; and

WHEREAS the Twin Lakes Golf and Country Club and others have petitioned King County to approve a planned unit development, Land Use Management File No. 407-73-P, which includes approximately two acres of the Twin Lakes Golf Course; and

WHEREAS the deletion of the two acres from the current use application would not change the open space character of either the two acre tract or the one hundred and six acres which would remain in the current use application; and

WHEREAS the current use application can be amended without constituting a withdrawal or breach of the open space taxation agreement between King County and Twin Lakes Golf and Country Club because said agreement has not yet been executed by said parties,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: That portion of the Twin Lakes Golf Course which is included in the planned unit development application designated by Land Use Management File No. 407-73-P is hereby deleted from the

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current use classification application designated by Land
Use Management File No. 407-72-S.
