A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to execute and submit a grant application to the State Law & Justice Planning Office for funds in the amount of \$102,674 to continue support of The Ark, a crisis intervention center for teen-age girls, File No. 73-L-327.

WHEREAS, the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968, as amended, provides for the award of grants by Law Enforcement Assistance Administration, U.S. Department of Justice, through the Washington State Law & Justice Planning Office, and

whereas, the County Council recognizes the need for an intensive intervention service for girls expressing delinquent behavior or undergoing crisis situations that may require short-term residential care and counseling to prevent them from becoming wards of the court, and

WHEREAS, King County recognizes its obligation to provide \$20,600 in kind contribution and to provide \$13,820 in a cash match for support of this project,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. That the King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the amount of \$102,674 to the State Law & Justice Planning Office on behalf of King County;

2. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to file and execute such application and contracts as are required by the State;

3. That the Federal/State Relations Division is named the authorized correspondent for King County and is further authorized to furnish such additional information and documents as may be required by the State;

That the County Executive is also authorized to enter l into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project. 5. That the United States of America, Department of Justice, and the State of Washington are hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
