A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to execute and submit a grant application to the U.S. Department of Justice, Law Enforcement Assistance Administration, for funds in the amount of \$200,500 to establish a Residential Burglary Prevention Project, 73-L-322.

WHEREAS, the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968, as amended, provides for the award of grants by the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration, U.S. Department of Justice, and

WHEREAS, residential burglary in Southwest King County is a significant community problem, and

WHEREAS, the proposed Residential Burglary Prevention Project as defined in King County grant No. 73-L-322 will reduce the number of burglaries and increase the percent of recovery of stolen property in the target area, and

WHEREAS, King County recognizes its obligation to provide \$39,455 in-kind contribution and to provide \$27,378 in a cash match for support of this project,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. That the King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the amount of \$200,500 to the U.S. Department of Justice, Law Enforcement Assistance Administration on behalf of King County.

2. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to file and execute such application and contracts as are required.

3. That the Federal/State Relations Division is named the authorized correspondent for King County and is further authorized to furnish such additional information and documents as may be required.

4. That the County Executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project.


5. That the United States of America, Department of Justice, is hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
