A MOTION to set the date for a hearing upon the Assessment Roll for Road Improvement District No. 54 for underground wiring in the Sheridan Beach area.

WHEREAS, King County Ordinance No. 413 created King County Road Improvement District No. 54 for the conversion of existing overhead wiring to underground wiring and the erection of ornamental street lights in the Sheridan Beach area. The conversion has been completed and the cost is now known; and

WHEREAS, King County Ordinance No. 413 directed the Director of the Department of Public Works to prepare and file with the King County Council Administrator an Assessment Roll for the cost and expense of the improvement when the entire cost is known. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

SECTION 1: Pursuant to the provisions of R.C.W. 36.88.090,

the hearing upon the Assessment Roll for King County Road Improvement District No. 5¹+ shall be scheduled for June 25,

1973, at 9:30 a.m.

SECTION 2: The King County Council will sit as a board of equalization for the purpose of considering aforesaid Assessment Roll at aforesaid hearing and will consider such objections make thereto, or any part thereof, and will correct, revise, raise, lower, change or modify said roll or any part thereof, or set aside said roll in order that such assessment be made de novo as to such body shall appear just and equitable and then proceed to confirm the same by ordinance.

SECTION 3: The Council Administrator of the King County Council is hereby directed to give notice of hearing upon said roll to all owners or reputed owners of the property whose name appears thereon, by mailing a notice thereof at least fifteen days before the date fixed for the hearing to such owners or

reputed owners at the address of such owner as shown on the tax rolls of the King County Office of Comptroller; and in addition thereto such notice shall be published at least two times in a newspaper of general circulation in the County. Such notices shall specify the time and place of hearing on said roll and shall notify all persons who may desire to object thereto to make such objections in writing and to file same with the Council Administrator of King County at or prior to the date fixed for said hearing.
