

MOTION NO. 1183

1 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to
2 execute and submit a grant application to the
3 State Law & Justice Planning Office for funds
4 in the amount of \$48,963 to continue the
5 work of the Criminal Justice Coordinating
6 Council, 73-L-331

7 WHEREAS, the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of
8 1968, as amended, provides for the award of grants by the Law
9 Enforcement Assistance Administration, U.S. Department of Justice,
10 through the Washington State Law & Justice Planning Office, and

11 WHEREAS, the Criminal Justice Coordinating Council is a
12 necessary forum to discuss problems of the criminal justice
13 system with key law enforcement, government and citizens repre-
14 sentatives, and

15 WHEREAS, the proposed work of the Council outlined in
16 proposed grant 73-L-331 will significantly increase the usefulness
17 of said Council to those involved in developing an efficient
18 criminal justice system, and

19 WHEREAS, King County recognizes its obligation to provide
20 \$8,161 in a cash match for support of this project,

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King
22 County:

23 1. That the King County Executive is hereby authorized to
24 make application for funds in the amount of \$48,963 to the State
25 Law & Justice Planning Office on behalf of King County;

26 2. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and
27 directed to file and execute such application and contracts as
28 are required by the State;

29 3. That the Federal/State Relations Division is named
30 the authorized correspondent for King County and is further
31 authorized to furnish such additional information and documents
32 as may be required by the State;


