

MOTION NO. 1181

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to execute and submit a grant application to the State Law & Justice Planning Office for funds in the amount of \$12,000 to assist in the technical training of officers of the King County Department of Public Safety, 3-L-336.

WHEREAS, the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968, as amended, provides for the award of grants by the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration, U.S. Department of Justice, through the Washington State Law & Justice Planning Office, and

WHEREAS, the King County Department of Public Safety is in need of additional funds for the technical training of police personnel, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of King County to have professional, well-trained police officers, and

WHEREAS, King County recognizes its obligation to provide \$2,744 in-kind contribution and to provide \$3,600 in a cash match for support of this project,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. That the King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the amount of \$12,000 to the State Law & Justice Planning Office on behalf of King County;

2. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to file and execute such application and contracts as are required by the State;

3. That the Federal/State Relations Division is named the authorized correspondent for King County and is further authorized to furnish such additional information and documents as may be required by the State;

4. That the County Executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project.
