A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to execute and submit a grant application to the . Robert Wood Johnson Foundation for funds in the amount of \$400,000 to establish an Integrated Emergency Medical Services System for Seattle-King County, M-344

WHEREAS, the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation, a private national philanthropic organization, has established a competitive program aimed at providing basic support for the establishment of regional emergency medical communications systems, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the citizens of King County to have available immediate emergency medical service,

- That the King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the amount of \$400,000 to the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation, a private, national philanthropic organization on behalf of King County.
- That the County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to file and execute such application and contracts as are required by the Robert Wood Foundation.
- That the Federal/State Relations Division is named the authorized correspondent for King County and is further authorized to furnish such additional information and documents as may be required by the Foundation.
