

A MOTION relating to the grant of a Sewer Line Easement to the City of Seattle.

WHEREAS, the City of Seattle, a Municipal Corporation of King County, Washington, has made application for the right to construct a sewer main with necessary appurtenances over, upon and across the land described herein, said sewer main to replace a sewer main easement previously granted by King County to the City of Seattle and now needed for King County purposes, and

WHEREAS, the said sewer main crosses lands which are held by King County in the Samuel Maple Donation Claim No. 49, and

WHEREAS, investigation reveals that it would be to the County's advantage and in the best interest of the citizens of King County, to grant to the City of Seattle the requested easement,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

That the County Executive is authorized to sign and deliver the necessary sewer line agreement granting to the City of Seattle, a Municipal Corporation of King County, Washington, an easement for a sewer main with necessary appurtenances over, upon and across the following described property situated in King County, Washington:

A 10 foot strip of land over and across the Samuel Maple Donation Claim No. 49, the centerline of which is described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the West line of said Donation Claim with the centerline of Airport Way So.; Thence So. 38°46'18" E. along said centerline 645.24 feet; Thence So. 51°13'42" W. 105.40 feet to the true point of beginning; Thence No. 51°13'42" E. 60.40 feet; Thence So. 38°46'18" E. 957.40 feet; Thence So. 51°13'42" W. 60.40 feet to the terminus of said line; said terminus being So. 38°46'18" E. 98.12 feet and So. 51°13'42" W. 105.40 feet from the intersection of the centerline of Airport Way So. with the East - West centerline of Sec. 28, Twp 24 No., Rge 3 East, W.M.
