

A Motion Relating to the Grant of a Storm Drain Easement to City of Seattle

1 WHEREAS, City of Seattle, a Municipal Corporation of King
 2 County, Washington, has made application for the right to con-
 3 struct storm drain with necessary appurtenances over, upon and
 4 across the land described herein, and

5 WHEREAS, the said storm drain crosses lands which are held
 6 by King County as tax title property in Lot 6, Block 3, Sea View
 7 Park Addition, and

8 WHEREAS, investigation reveals that it would be to the
 9 County's advantage and in the best interest of the citizens of
 10 King County, to grant to the City of Seattle the requested ease-
 11 ment;

12 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

13 That the County Executive is authorized to sign and deliver
 14 the necessary storm drain agreement granting to the City of
 15 Seattle, a Municipal Corporation of King County, Washington, an
 16 easement for storm drain with necessary appurtenances over, upon
 17 and across the following described property situated in King
 18 County, Washington:

19 Portion of Lot 6, Block 3, Replat of Block 47 and
 20 Block 45, Sea View Park Addition, as recorded in
 21 Volume 17 of Plats, page 100, Records of King County,
 22 Washington, described as follows: Beginning at the
 23 southwest corner of said Lot 6; thence south 89°27'
 24 28" east along the south line of said lot 8.41 feet;
 25 thence north 34°15'50" east 16.27 feet; thence north
 26 9°00'50" east 36.92 feet to the north line of said
 27 lot; thence north 89°27'28" west along said north
 28 line 3.59 feet to the northeast corner of said lot;
 29 thence south 1°07'27" west along the westerly line
 30 of said lot 21.46 feet; thence continuing along said
 31 westerly line south 34°14'50" west 34.37 feet to
 32 the beginning;
