

A Motion Relating to the Grant of a Storm Drain Easement to the Russak Investment Company

1 WHEREAS, the Russak Investment Company has made application  
2 for the right to construct a storm drain easement with the nec-  
3 essary appurtenances to connect with King County 33" V.C.P. storm  
4 drain over, upon and across the land described herein, and

5 WHEREAS, the said storm drain crosses lands which are held by  
6 King County in the Francis McNatt Donation, Claim No. 38, and

7 WHEREAS, investigation reveals that it would be to the  
8 County's advantage and in the best interest of the citizens of  
9 King County, to grant to Russak Investment Company the requested  
10 easement,

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

12 That the County Executive is authorized to sign and deliver  
13 the necessary storm drain easement granting to the Russak Invest-  
14 ment Company for the consideration of mutual benefit, an easement  
15 for a storm drain with necessary appurtenances over, upon and  
16 across the following described property situated in King County,  
17 Washington:

18 A strip of land in the Francis McNatt Donation  
19 Claim No. 38 in Section 33, Township 24, Range  
20 4 East, W.M., in King County, Washington, with  
21 the centerline of said strip described as fol-  
22 lows: Beginning at the intersection of the  
23 easterly margin of East Marginal Way with the  
24 north line of said Donation Claim, thence South  
25 23°40'59" East along said easterly margin, 542.01  
26 feet; thence North 89°58'17" East, 135 feet to  
27 the true point of beginning of said centerline;  
28 thence North 0°01'43" West, 34 feet to the termi-  
29 nus of this line.
