A MOTION indicating the Council's approval of reclassification of certain property belonging to J & A Auto, designated Land Use Management File No. 111-73-P

WHEREAS the recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner on the application of J & A Auto for a reclassification of property, Land Use Management File No. 111-73-P has been appealed; and

WHEREAS the applicant has demonstrated the expansion of his wrecking yard is essential to the public interest and can be accommodated without unreasonable harm to other properties; and

WHEREAS the Council finds the Zoning and Subdivision

Examiner made an error in judgement when he concluded that the

reclassification of the property to M-H, subject to conditions,

would be detrimental to other properties;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: The application of J & A Auto for a reclassification of property, File No. 111-73-P, shall be approved with the following modifications and subject to the satisfaction of the following conditions:

1. That the M-H classification is granted for the sole purpose of permitting the expansion of the existing wrecking yard, that no other heavy manufacturing use shall be permitted, and that the classification shall without further Council action revert to M-P upon the discontinuance of said use.

2. That a screening and landscaping plan, including maintainance, which meets the Council's intent as expressed in the attached Exhibit A, is required
