A MOTION authorizing the King County Executive to enter into the appropriate contracts for animal sheltering and animal neutering/spaying.

WHEREAS, the Council of King County finds that the existing animal shelter is inadequate; and

WHEREAS, the Council of King County finds that a coordinated program with the City of Seattle is the least expensive method of providing animal shelter services for the residents of Seattle and King County, and

WHEREAS, the Council of King County intends that the animals in North King County be sheltered in that area; and that the animals in East King County be sheltered in that area; and

WHEREAS, the Council of King County intends that an animal shelter be built in South King County where 65% of the county's animal control enforcement takes place; and

WHEREAS, the Council of King County intends that a low-cost neuter/spay program be established.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County Executive is authorized to proceed with plans to construct a shelter in South King County. The County intends to provide shelter for North County animals at the City of Seattle facility and to enter into contracts to shelter East County animals.
