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2 A MOTION concurring with the recommendation
3 of the Deputy Zoning and Subdivision Examiner
4 and denying the appeal by Harold L. Brandt,
5 designated File No. 117-73-P, and adding con-
6 ditions thereto.

7 WHEREAS the King County Council has reviewed the written
8 recommendation of the Deputy Zoning and Subdivision Examiner
9 attached hereto, which was filed with the Clerk of the Council on
10 July 25, 1973, regarding the application for reclassification
11 petitioned by Harold L. Brandt, designated by the Land Use
12 Management Division, Department of Community and Environmental
13 Development File No. 117-73-P.

14 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

15 The Council does concur with the recommendations of the
16 Deputy Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, dated July 17, 1973,
17 with the following amended conditions:

18 Condition 2 (b) is amended to read:

19 If developed with any other permitted uses
20 within the zone, the amount of floor space,
21 the location and design of the structure and
22 the type of use for which it is designed to
23 be further regulated to provide a low-intensity
24 use and a residentially-compatible structure.

25 Condition 2 (d) is amended to read:

26 The size, location and design of signs are to
27 be consistent with the design of the structures
28 and the landscaping plans.
