

MOTION NO. 1303

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A MOTION declaring the intention of the King County Council to create a Sewer Utility Local Improvement District in the Trend area.

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the King County Council requesting the formation of a sewer utility local improvement district in the Trend area, and

WHEREAS, the Council Administrator of the King County Council referred the above noted petition to the Director of the Department of Public Works for investigation and report back to the King County Council, and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Public Works has determined that said petition has been signed by the owners of the majority of area of the property within the proposed sewer utility local improvement district, and that the improvement appears to be feasible, and that the benefits appear to exceed the cost of the improvement, and

WHEREAS, King County is authorized to carry out the work in accordance with provisions of 36.94 R.C.W., the County Area Services Act,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

SECTION 1: It is the intention of the County Council of King County, Washington, to create a utility local improvement district in the Trend area described as:

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Beginning at the N.E. corner of Sec. 33, Twp. 26 N., Rg. 5E., W.M., thence southerly along the east line of said Sec. 33 to the south line of the N.E. 1/4 of the N.E. 1/4 of said Sec. 33, thence west along said south line to the east line of the west half of the east half of said Sec. 33, thence south along said east line to its intersection with the centerline of N.E. 107th Pl. (in the S.E. 1/4 of said Sec. 33), thence west along said centerline to its intersection with the N.-S. centerline of said Sec. 33, thence north along said N-S centerline to the north line of said Sec. 33, thence east along said north line to the N.E. corner of said Sec. 33 and the point of beginning.

SECTION 2: The Director of the Department of Public Works is directed to proceed with the survey, mapping, calculation and drawings necessary to prepare a preliminary assessment roll for the proposed sewer service area.
