WHEREAS, the proposed grant project to the Department of Scology will provide for leachate collection and control system for the disposal park and sewage system for the Alcoholic Treatment Center, and,

WHEREAS, the County recognizes its obligation to provide as support to this program approximately \$44,800 in contributed goods and services and \$190,000 as a cash match,
