- 2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to file and execute such application and contracts as are required by the U.S. Department of Health, Education and Welfare;
- 3. The Federal/State Relations Division is named the authorized correspondent for King County and is further authorized to furnish such additional information and documents as may be required by the U.S. Department of Health, Education and Welfare;
