A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to execute and submit a grant application to the State Law and Justice Planning Office for funds in the amount of \$110,155 to provide funds for employment of administrative start-up staff and pre-trial release interviewer staff for the proposed King County Department of Rehabilitative Services, BPP-360

WHEREAS, the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968, as amended, provides for the award of grants by the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration, U. S. Department of Justice, through the Washington State Law and Justice Planning Office, and

WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes the need for a King County Department of Rehabilitative Services, and

WHEREAS, the proposed grant will provide needed start-up monies associated with establishing a Department of Rehabilitative Services and also provide necessary funds to employ interviewers to perform the duties required by the new rules for the Superior Court regarding pre-trial release, and

WHEREAS, the County recognizes its obligation to provide as support to this program approximately \$12,239 as a cash match,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED By the Council of King County:

- 1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the amount of \$110,155 to the State Law and Justice Planning Office on behalf of King County for staffing of the proposed King County Department of Rehabilitative Services.
- 2. The County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to file and execute such application and contracts as are required by the State.
