MOTION NO., 1435

A MOTION directing the Executive to phase out the milk inspection program and transferring responsibility to the State.

WHEREAS, milk inspection is a state responsibility under RCW 15.32.090.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County Executive is hereby informed that King County will no longer locally fund a milk inspection program nor perform the milk inspection function.

The Director of the Seattle-King County Health Department shall work with the Department of Agriculture in developing a phase-out program for milk inspection. Such phase-out shall be completed by September 1, 1974.

BE IT FURTHER MOVED, the employees of the Seattle-King
County Health Department who will not be transferring to the
State Department of Agriculture, shall be absorbed by the SeattleKing County Health Department by July 1, 1974, from positions
that have been budgeted in 1974, but are presently vacant.

To insure the wholesomeness of milk and dairy products to the citizens of King County, the Seattle-King County Health Department shall provide a program of surveillance of retail milk products and frozen dairy products inspection.
