WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes the problem of alcoholism in King County, a magnitude of which justified concerted effort of Federal, State and local government, and

WHEREAS, the County recognizes its obligation to maintain the current level of alcoholism services it provides to the citizens of King County,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- 1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to enter into contracts for 1974, in the amount of \$492,874 with the State of Washington, Department of Social and Health Services on behalf of King County;
- 2. The County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to file and execute such application and contracts as are required by the State;
- 3. The Federal/State Relations Division is named the authorized correspondent for King County and is further authorized to furnish such additional information and documents as may be required by the State;
