1974 - 257

1 A MOTION assigning certain specific
2 tasks to legislative branch offices
3 and staff for 1974.

4 WHEREAS, the King County Council wishes to have accomplished
5 certain tasks by its offices and staff during the year 1974,
6 and

7 WHEREAS, the Council wishes to have an official record
8 of these assignments, and

9 WHEREAS, it has been deemed inappropriate to include
10 such assignments in the expression of legislative intent which
11 is directed primarily toward the executive and judicial
12 branches of government,

13 NOW THEREFORE, be it moved by the Council of King County:

14 1. That the King County Auditor perform a fiscal and
15 operational audit in 1974 of the Intercounty River activity.

16 2. That the Council Administrator, with cooperation and
17 participation from the Public Works, Budget and Program Planning,
18 and Community Development Departments, conduct a feasibility
19 study of single, county-wide water and sewer, and drainage
20 district, under provisions of state law. This study shall be
21 completed within six months of completion of the RIBCO water
22 basic plan.

23 3. That the Council Administrator conduct a study, to be
24 completed by May 30, 1974, of the feasibility of a four-day
25 week or other modification of county working hours with the
26 objective of alleviating the energy crisis.

27 4. That the Council staff perform cash audits at least
28 annually, of all organizations financed in whole or in part
29 by county funds.


1 5. That the Council Administrator, with the cooperation
