3 A MOTION relating to Pedestrian Safety, and  
4 adopting a King County Pedestrian Safety  
5 Manual for comprehensive planning and con-  
6 struction of paths and sidewalks.

7 WHEREAS, in the opinion of the King County Council,  
8 pedestrian safety is the responsibility of all citizens as well  
9 as that of parents, school organizations, law enforcement agencies,  
10 local governments, and of drivers and pedestrians, and

11 WHEREAS, in the opinion of the King County Council, everyone  
12 who is morally or legally responsible for pedestrian safety  
13 should be actively involved in the development of solutions to  
14 the problems of providing safe passage for all pedestrians, and

15 WHEREAS, King County has previously indicated a concern for  
16 the safety of pedestrians by the adoption of Resolution No. 28148  
17 on June 22, 1964, and also by Motion of the King County Council  
18 No. 145 passed on March 16, 1970, and

19 WHEREAS, the King County Council has determined that a need  
20 exists for a county-wide Comprehensive Pedestrian Safety Program  
21 that will establish the needs and priorities for pedestrian  
22 safety improvements in order that fiscal needs can be determined  
23 and programmed, and

24 WHEREAS, the King County Council has caused to be prepared  
25 a Pedestrian Safety Manual as a guideline for developing a  
26 Comprehensive Pedestrian Safety Program;

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:


28 The King County Council hereby declares that the guidelines
