WHEREAS, The County recognizes its obligation to provide, as support to this program, \$12,500 as a local cash match, NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED By the Council of King County:

- That the County Executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project.
