

MOTION 1565

1 A MOTION declaring the intention of the King  
2 County Council and the City of Seattle to  
3 engage consultants to study feasibility, cost  
4 and management control appropriate for joint  
5 or cooperative computer services for said  
6 governments.

7 WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Relations Committees of  
8 Seattle and King County have passed a joint resolution (4-11-74)  
9 declaring their intention to work closely in pursuing the  
10 opportunities for cooperations, coordination, or consolidation  
11 in the data processing field; and

12 WHEREAS, subsequent discussions between the two agencies have  
13 determined that outside consultants should be engaged to determine  
14 the feasibility of a joint operation before the City releases a  
15 comprehensive Request for Proposal for an independent data proces-  
16 sing capability;

17 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED be the Council of King County:

18 The King County Council declares their intention to jointly  
19 with the City of Seattle hire a team of consultants in order to  
20 determine the feasibility and costs of cooperative or consolidated  
21 data processing services between the City of Seattle, The County of  
22 King and/or other governmental agencies.


23 BE IT FURTHER MOVED a supervisory committee shall be estab-  
24 lished which shall be composed of two representatives from the  
25 City and two representatives from the County Intergovernmental  
26 Relations Committees, plus one representative for the County  
27 Executive and one for the Mayor. The study team shall present  
28 progress reports and interim findings to the supervisory committee.  
29 The supervisory committee may terminate the study by mutual  
30 agreement at any point. City and County technical representatives  
31 will review and comment on material presented to the Supervisory  
32 Committee.

33 BE IT FURTHER MOVED the final recommendations shall be re-  
ceived from the consultants within sixty days of their engagement

1 and King County agrees to financially participate equally with the  
2 City of Seattle in total consulting fees not to exceed \$35,000.00.
