MOTION NO.

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to proceed with certain specified actions toward the establishment of governmental service centers in North, South and East King County.

WHEREAS, the Council has appropriated \$600,000 from 1972

Federal Shared Revenue to the Building Modernization Construction Fund
to establish governmental service centers in North, South and East King

County, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1647 provided that the appropriated funds should not be expended without approval of the King County Council, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1647 directed the King County Executive to present to the King County Council detailed plans for each governmental center to include the dollar estimate and governmental services to be offered before approval to expend the funds should be given, and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Community and Environmental Development met with the Budget and Long Range Planning Committee of the Council on May 27, 1974, and discussed a proposal for proceeding in the establishment of governmental service centers, and

WHEREAS, the Budget and Long Range Planning Committee of the Council has endorsed these recommendations as amended in the committee meeting on May 27, 1974.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to have the Division of Property Management entertain proposals for a lease/option to purchase a newly-constructed facility of approximately 10,000 square feet to house the Burien Precinct Station.

- 2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to proceed with the site acquisition, design and construction of the North Precinct station, to be located in the Kenmore-Bothell area; PROVIDED that the detailed design of the facility shall be approved by the Council before construction contracts are entered into.
- 3. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to proceed with negotiations with the Highline School District for use of a surplus elementary school for a Burien Community Center-Governmental Services Center. The County Executive shall obtain Council approval before final agreement.
- 4. The King County Executive is hereby directed to continue study of an East Side Governmental Service Center with the understanding that it would be the next facility to be considered for construction as part of the Governmental Service Center program. This study should be returned to the Council within 60 days.
