1 A MOTION Authorizing the County Executive to
2 Execute and Submit a Grant Application to the
3 State Law and Justice Planning Office for Funds
4 in the Amount of \$2,668, and to the Law Enforce-
5 ment Assistance Administration, U.S. Department
6 of Justice, for Funds in the Amount of \$48,021
7 for the Support of the King County Law and Justice
8 Planning Functions.

9 WHEREAS, The Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of
10 1968, as amended, provides for the award of grants by the Law En-
11 forcement Assistance Administration, U.S. Department of Justice,
12 through the Washington State Law and Justice Planning Office, and

13 WHEREAS, The King County Council recognizes the need to
14 support King County Law and Justice Planning activities, and

15 WHEREAS, The County recognizes its obligation to provide
16 as support to this program \$2,668, as a cash match,

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED By the Council of King County:

18 1. That the King County Executive is hereby authorized to
19 make application for funds in the amount of \$2,668 to the State
20 Law and Justice Planning Office, and \$48,021 to the Law Enforce-
21 ment Assistance Administration, U.S. Department of Justice, on be-
22 half of King County;

23 2. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and
24 directed to file and execute such application and contracts as are
25 required by the State;

26 3. That the Federal/State Relations Division is named the
27 authorized correspondent for King County, and is further author-
28 ized to furnish such additional information and documents as may
29 be required by the State;

30 4. That the County Executive is also authorized to enter
31 into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the im-
32 plementation of the project.

1 5. That the United States of America, Department of
2 Justice, and the State of Washington are hereby assured full com-
3 pliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
