A MOTION Authorizing the County Executive to Execute and Submit Grant Applications to the Department of Health, Education and Welfare, and the LEAA, for the King County Youth Service Bureau System for Funds in the Amount of \$56,500 and \$145,833, Respectively.

WHEREAS, The Department of Health, Education and Welfare, and LEAA, provide funds for youth services to prevent delinquency and reduce recidivism, and

WHEREAS, The County Council recognizes the need to provide comprehensive services for youth in an effort to prevent delinquency and reduce recidivism, and

WHEREAS, This grant would support a coordinated program to provide these services to youth, primarily with behavorial problems, and thus assist them in becoming good and useful citizens, and

WHEREAS, The County recognizes its obligation to provide as support to this program \$8,101, as a Cash Match,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED By the Council of King County:

- 1. The King County Executive is authorized to make application for funds in the amount of \$145,833 to LEAA, and \$56,500 to the Department of Health, Education and Welfare, on behalf of King County;
- 2. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to file and execute such application and contracts as are required by the State;
- 3. That the Federal/State Relations Division is named the authorized correspondent for King County and is further authorized to furnish such additional information and documents as may be required by the State;

4. That the County Executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project.

- 5. That the United States of America, Department of Justice, and the State of Washington are hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
- 6. That the King County Council shall review the evaluation report prior to the allocation of the full grant funds for the second year of operation.
