

MOTION NO. 1609

1 A MOTION Authorizing the County Executive to  
 2 Execute and Submit a Grant Application to the  
 3 Law Enforcement Assistance Administration,  
 4 U.S.Department of Justice, for Funds in the  
 5 Amount of \$71,986, and to the State Law and  
 6 Justice Planning Office for Funds in the Amount  
 7 of \$4,000, for Support of the King County Pub-  
 8 lic Defender Presentence Counseling Project.

9 WHEREAS, The Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act  
 10 of 1968, as amended, provides for the award of grants by the Law  
 11 Enforcement Assistance Administration, U.S.Department of Justice,  
 12 through the Washington State Law and Justice Planning Office, and

13 WHEREAS, The King County Council recognizes the need to  
 14 comply with Superior Court regulations governing pre-sentence re-  
 15 ports by defense counsel, and

16 WHEREAS, This project will increase the opportunity for  
 17 proper court evaluation at sentencing, and

18 WHEREAS, The County recognizes its obligation to provide  
 19 as support to this program \$4,000 as a cash match;

20 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED By the Council of King County:

21 1. That the King County Executive is hereby authorized to  
 22 make application for funds in the amount of \$71,986 to the Law  
 23 Enforcement Assistance Administration, U.S.Department of Justice,  
 24 on behalf of King County, and \$4,000 from the State Law and Jus-  
 25 tice Planning Office;

26 2. That the United States of America, Department of Jus-  
 27 tice, and the State of Washington are hereby assured full compli-  
 28 ance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
