2 A MOTION endorsing July 28, 1974 as Highline
3 Bicycle Sunday: authorizing King County to
4 provide assistance in planning activities to
5 insure the public safety and welfare.

6 WHEREAS, various community groups in the Highline area of
7 King County have joined together in a unified effort to promote
8 the enjoyment derived from bicycling; and

9 WHEREAS, planned community activities will be held on July 28,
10 1974 and be known as Highline Bicycle Sunday; and

11 WHEREAS, the proposed Highline Bicycle Sunday shall have a
12 planned route, by bicycle, to and from public areas in the High-
13 line area, thereby promoting their future use by citizens of the
14 Highline Community; and

15 WHEREAS, citizens and groups of the Highline community have
16 planned procedures to insure the safety and welfare of partici-
17 pants and the citizens of Highline; and

18 WHEREAS, planned safety procedures require the aid and co-
19 ordination of community groups and King County government, specif-
20 ically the Departments of Public Works and Public Safety; and

21 WHEREAS, the Council approves and endorses the civic pur-
22 poses of the Highline Bicycle Day and encourages citizen involve-
23 ment in the affairs of their community;

24 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

25 The Council of King County recognizes July 28, 1974, as
26 Highline Bicycle Sunday; and authorizes the applicable depart-
27 ments of King County to provide assistance to involved community
