

MOTION NO. 1644

1 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to  
2 execute and submit a grant renewal application  
3 to the Department of Health, Education and Welfare  
4 for funds in the amount of \$1,002,834 for contin-  
5 uation of the Central Alcoholism Agency Staffing  
6 Project.

7 WHEREAS, the federal Uniform Alcoholism and Intoxication Act  
8 (PL 91-616), 1971, provides for the award of grants by the Depart-  
9 ment of Health, Education and Welfare through the National Insti-  
10 tute of Mental Health and National Institute of Alcohol, Abuse and  
11 Alcoholism, and

12 WHEREAS, the Central Alcoholism Agency, a division of the  
13 Seattle-King County Health Department, has been formed and is  
14 currently operating under an eight-year staffing grant from the  
15 Department of Health, Education and Welfare, which grant requires  
16 an annual renewal application, and

17 WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes the efficacy of and  
18 need to support services for prevention, diagnosis and treatment  
19 of alcoholism, through the Central Alcoholism Agency, and

20 WHEREAS, the County recognizes its obligation to continue its  
21 support of this program by providing approximately \$149,500 as a  
22 cash match in support of this project,

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

24 1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to execute  
25 and submit an application on behalf of King County, Washington,  
26 for a continuation grant from the Department of Health, Education  
27 and Welfare in the amount of \$1,002,834 to aid the County in deal-  
28 ing with alcoholism prevention, diagnosis and treatment.

29 2. The County Executive is hereby authorized and directed  
30 to file and execute such application and contracts as required by  
31 the Department of Health, Education and Welfare.

32 3. The Central Alcoholism Agency, a division of the Seattle-  
33 King County Department of Public Health, will staff the proposed  
project.
