WHEREAS, the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968, as amended. provides for the award of grants by the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration, U.S. Department of Justice, through the Washington State Law & Justice Planning Office, and

WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes the need to assist adolescent girls who are known to the court system or have behavior problems, and

WHEREAS, this grant would provide counseling and crisis intervention assistance to these girls residing in King County, and

WHEREAS, the County recognizes its obligation to provide as support to this program approximately \$1.333 as a cash match.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- 1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the amount of \$24,000 and \$1,333 as a State buy-in to the State Law & Justice Planning Office on behalf of King County;
- 2. The County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to file and execute such application and contracts as are required by the State;
- 3. The Federal/State Relations Division is named the authorized correspondent for King County and is further authorized to furnish such additional information and documents as may be required by the State;
- 4. The County Executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project.
