A MOTION authorizing the Executive to proceed with implementation of County participation in the Public Employment Program for the allocation period July 1, 1974 through March 31, 1975.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2112 provides that funds appropriated to the Public Employment Program for the allocation period July 1, 1974, through March 31, 1975, shall not be expended for participation of King County itself except as authorized by Motion of the Council; and

WHEREAS, hiring of PEP employees outside Career Service testing programs for ultimate absorption into the Career Service should be done in consonance with the budget process evaluation; and

WHEREAS, the 1975 Budget is now in the preparation process; and

WHEREAS, the allocation of PEP positions for the noted allocation period contemplates 64 positions which would terminate at the end of the allocation period, 17 positions the occupants of which would be absorbed into regular County positions through attrition and 13 positions which may be converted to County funding at a later date; and

WHEREAS, current projections indicate the 1975 budget may provide for fewer employees than currently budgeted and such a possibility must be taken into consideration prior to the hiring of 30 employees to be absorbed through attrition or provided new positions from County funding,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: The Executive is hereby authorized to expend funds appropriated in Ordinance No. 2112 as necessary to fill 64 temporary positions.

The Executive is hereby requested to defer filling the remaining 30 positions until their allocation can be reviewed and
