A MOTION approving the Preliminary Plat of West Campus Business and Office Park Replat, designated File No. 674-2, and modifying the conditions of approval recommended by the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner.

MOTION NO.

WHEREAS, the recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner dated June 11, 1974 on the Preliminary Plat of West Campus Business and Office Park Replat, Land Use Management File No. 674-2 has been appealed; and

WHEREAS, the King County Council has reviewed the record and the written appeal arguments in this matter; and

WHEREAS, the Council concludes that the access and parking restrictions recommended by the Examiner should be modified;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: The Preliminary Plat of West Campus Business and Office Park Replat, Land Use Management Division File No. 674-2, is approved as submitted May 28, 1974, subject to the conditions recommended by the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner in his report dated June 11, 1974 with the following modifications to Conditions 5-c and 5-d:

5-c. There shall be no direct vehicular access to South 348th Street from Lots No. 1 and No. 4. Direct vehicular access to South 348th Street from Lot No. 2 shall be permitted unless Lot No. 2 is sold together with either Lot No. 1 or Lot No. 3; in which event access shall be provided from Lot No. 2 to 9th Avenue South through either Lot No. 1 or Lot No. 3.

5-d. It is recommended that there be a restriction prohibiting any on-street parking on any street with a roadway width of 36 feet curb to curb or less.
