2 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to
3 Execute and Submit a Grant Application to the
4 National Endowment for the Arts for the Community
5 Planning, Design and Development Project for
6 funds in the Amount of \$25,500.

7 WHEREAS, The National Foundation of the Arts and Humanities
8 Act of 1965 enables the National Endowment for the Arts to provide
9 grants for projects in architecture, landscape architecture and
10 environmental design, and

11 WHEREAS, the County Council recognized the need to provide
12 educational opportunities to King County Youth in the fields of
13 environmental awareness, planning, government and the arts, and

14 WHEREAS, This grant would support the development and imple-
15 mentation of a high school curriculum covering these topics, and

16 WHEREAS, The County recognized its obligation to provide as
17 support to this program \$3,000 from the Arts Commission budget as
18 a cash match and \$39,000 as an in-kind contribution.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

20 1. The County Executive is authorized to make application
21 for funds in the amount of \$25,500 to the National Endowment for
22 the Arts, on behalf of King County;

23 2. The County Executive is hereby authorized and directed
24 to file and execute such applications and contracts as are
25 required by the National Endowment for the Arts;

26 3. The Federal/State Relations Division is named the author-
27 ized correspondent for King County and is further authorized to
28 furnish such additional information and documentation as may be
29 required by the State;


30 4. The County Executive is also authorized to enter into
31 and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the imple-
32 mentation of the project.

1 5. The project shall include one of
2 the inner city schools, Cleveland, Franklin or Garfield, subject
3 to the approval of the school district.

4 6. Acceptance by the school districts
5 involved of this addition to their curriculum is necessary before
6 funds are appropriated.
