2 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive
3 to enter into an agreement with the City
4 of Seattle and the Municipality of
5 Metropolitan Seattle entitled, "Memorandum
6 of Understanding for Joint Elderly/Handi-
7 capped Transportation Study"

8 WHEREAS, the County of King is engaged in and responsible
9 for all modes of transportation planning to meet the mobility
10 needs of its citizens, and

11 WHEREAS, the County of King is engaged in planning to
12 meet the human service needs of its citizens pursuant to
13 Motion No. 1161, and

14 WHEREAS, the City of Seattle is engaged in planning to
15 meet the human service needs of its citizens, including
16 transportation, and

17 WHEREAS, the Municipality of Metropolitan Seattle is
18 the official operator of public mass transportation within
19 the Seattle-King County Metropolitan Area, and responsible
20 for public mass transportation planning therefor, and

21 WHEREAS, it is necessary that the transportation and
22 human service planning of King County be coordinated with
23 the human service planning, including transportation, of the
24 City of Seattle, and the public mass transportation planning
25 of the Municipality of Metropolitan Seattle to improve the
26 social, health, employment, and recreational opportunities
27 for elderly and handicapped citizens of King County.


28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
