WHEREAS, the County of King is engaged in and responsible for all modes of transportation planning to meet the mobility needs of its citizens, and

WHEREAS, the County of King is engaged in planning to meet the human service needs of its citizens pursuant to Motion No. 1161, and

The King County Executive is hereby authorized to enter into a memorandum of understanding with the City of Seattle and the Municipality of Metropolitan Seattle herein attached,
