

MOTION NO. 1751

1 A MOTION adopting the 1975 King County Law  
2 and Justice Plan, and authorizing the County  
3 Executive to submit the Plan and formal grant  
4 applications for all funded 1975 King County  
5 projects contained therein to the Washington  
6 State Office of Community Development, Law  
7 and Justice Planning Office.

8 WHEREAS, the State of Washington's Law and Justice Planning  
9 Office and the State Committee on Law and Justice require that a  
10 regional plan be prepared and adopted by King County as a con-  
11 dition for King County's eligibility for the receipt of block  
12 grant funds made available to local governments under the pro-  
13 visions of the Crime Control Act of 1973, and,

14 WHEREAS, the State Committee on Law and Justice has alloc-  
15 ated 1975 Part "C" block grant funds to local regions on the  
16 basis of a formula and in doing so has required the preparation  
17 of regional plans whose combined project costs do not exceed the  
18 region's formula allocation, and,

19 WHEREAS, the 1975 King County Law and Justice Plan and pro-  
20 ject funding recommended by the King County Law and Justice  
21 Planning Committee best meets the needs of King County and parti-  
22 cipating suburban city governments given the fiscal constraint of  
23 the \$956,421 1975 formula allocation,

24 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- 25 1. The King County Council hereby approves and  
26 adopts the 1975 King County Law and Justice Plan  
27 and authorizes the County Executive to submit said  
28 Plan and to submit formal grant application for  
29 all funded King County projects contained therein  
30 to the Washington State Office of Community  
31 Development, Law and Justice Planning Office.  
32 2. Following official notification of grant award  
and prior to the beginning of planned activities;  
the Executive shall notify the Chairman of the  
Operations and Judiciary Committee, in writing,  
of any substantive changes in the approved



document necessitated by funding source review.  
The Operations and Judiciary Committee shall then  
prepare a motion authorizing said program changes.  
3. No funds shall be appropriated for any planned  
activity unless the proposed appropriation is  
accompanied by a "Memorandum of Agreement", prepared  
by the Executive. The "Memorandum of Agreement"  
shall clearly and concisely state the quantitative  
objectives of the planned activity. The agreement  
shall state the means and methods to be used,  
including time frames, in evaluating the ability  
of the program sponsor to accomplish stated  
objectives.
