A MOTION including the position of Assistant Property Tax Advisor in the 1975 King County budget.

WHEREAS, King County has established the office of Property Tax Advisor to render informational assistance to the public concerning property taxation, and

WHEREAS, the office has been operating with three established positions: a property tax advisor, an assistant property tax advisor, and a secretary, and

WHEREAS, the position of assistant property tax advisor has been funded for two years under the Federal Emergency Employment Act, and

WHEREAS, by ruling of the King-Snohomish Manpower Consortium, the funding of said position will continue only if the position is absorbed into the 1975 budget of King County, and


WHEREAS, the King County Council has determined that the level of service now provided to the public by said office shall continue,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The position of Assistant Property Tax Advisor shall be included in the 1975 budget of King County at the current salary level.

PASSED this 7th day of October, 1974.


